### 11. Plantation Drive & Alumni Connect (27th June 2025)

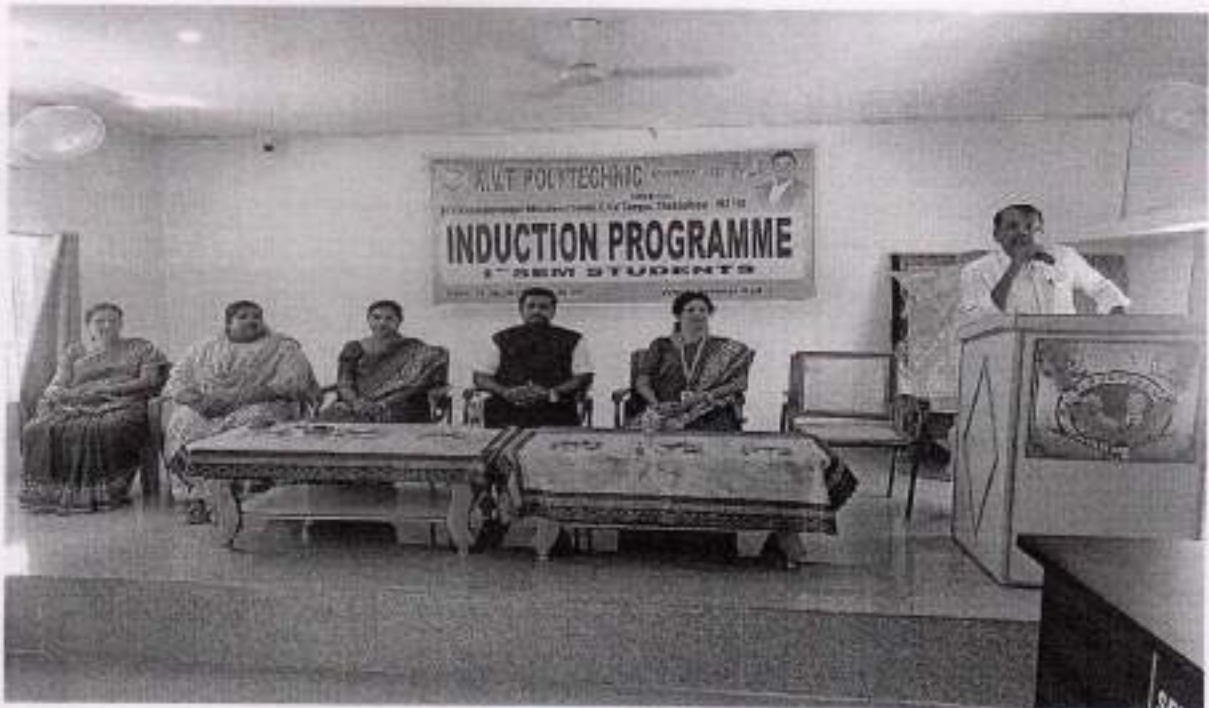
The NSS team organized a plantation drive within the campus. The Alumni Connect session enabled students to interact with successful alumni and learn about career paths and practical experiences.

## 12. Closing Ceremony (28th June 2025)

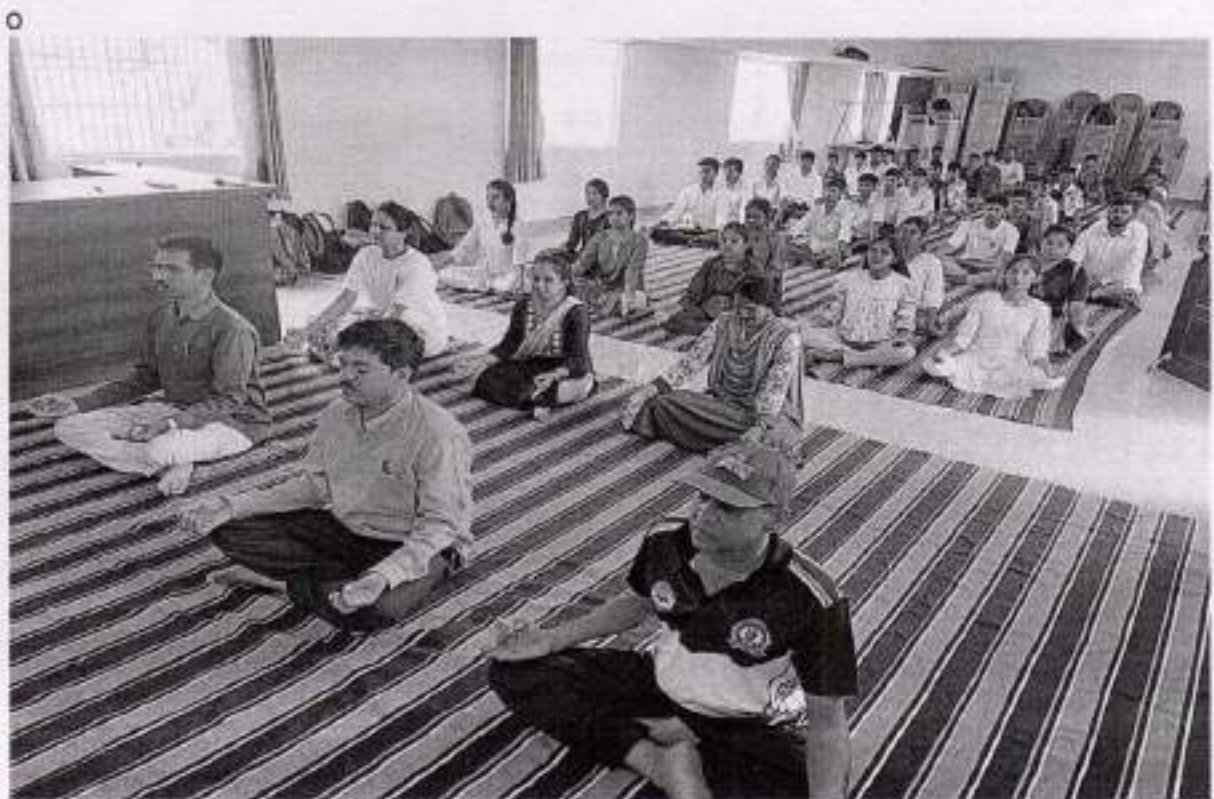
The final day included anti-ragging documentation, insurance enrollment, and a Valediction ceremony. Students shared feedback on their experience of the induction program.

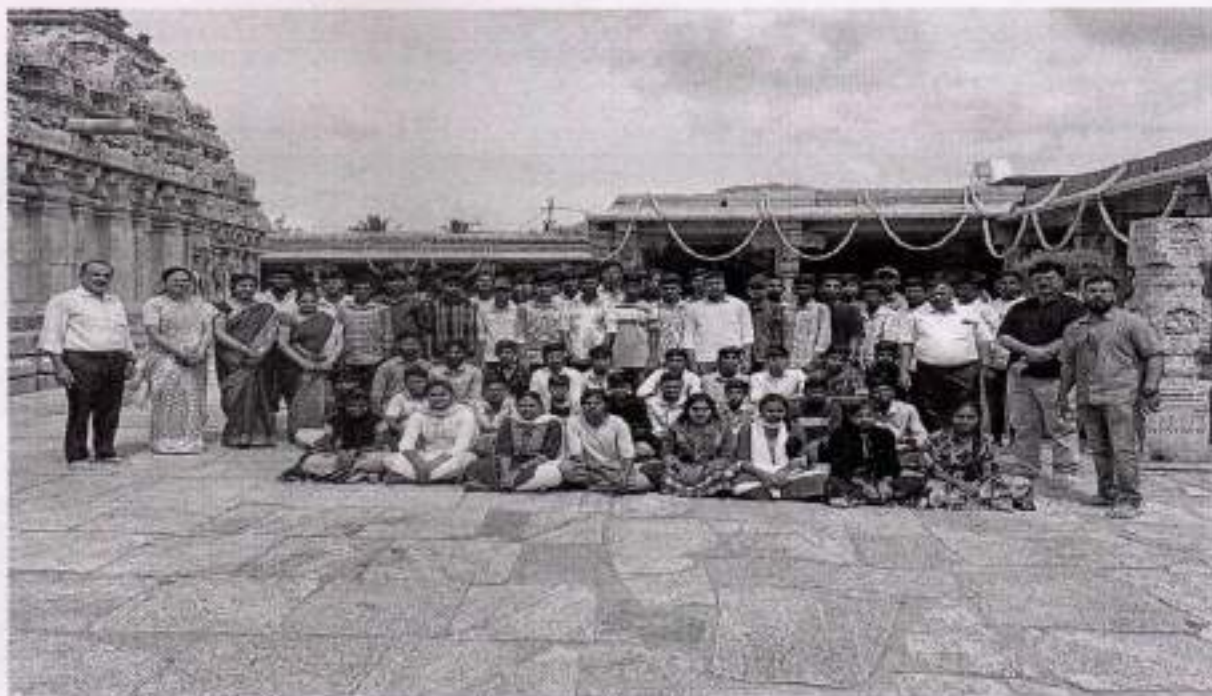
















### Conclusion:
